2.4 PostAgent Senior Design Team

2.5 User

2.6 Brand Book

A page where the user can give their brand voice to the AI so that it generates posts in their voice. This includes business address, what the business is about, what is the user website, etc.

2.7 Enchanter's Controls

This is where the user can design/create a reusable structure for automated weekly post generation drafts and AI drafts. The user can select up to 5 topics for the AI to use as the base point for the AI to generate posts, the user can also select type of text (topics, educational, etc.), and finally, the types of images (minimalist, typography, etc.)

2.8 Sorcerer's Spellbook

Sorcerer's spellbook allows the user to generate a post on demand, meaning that with one request image and the text are generated at once with one prompt unlike enchanter where the generation is slow and image and text are done separately.

2.9 Pixie Polish

Pixie polish is a tab or page where the user can edit, approve, and/or discard scheduled posts before they are published to social media. The user can edit manually or use AI to edit both image and the text.

2.10 Magic Metrics

This will be the page where the user will come to check on how their posts are doing. To keep it short, it's the analytics page. The data is pulled from all social media connected and analyzes that displays the results.
